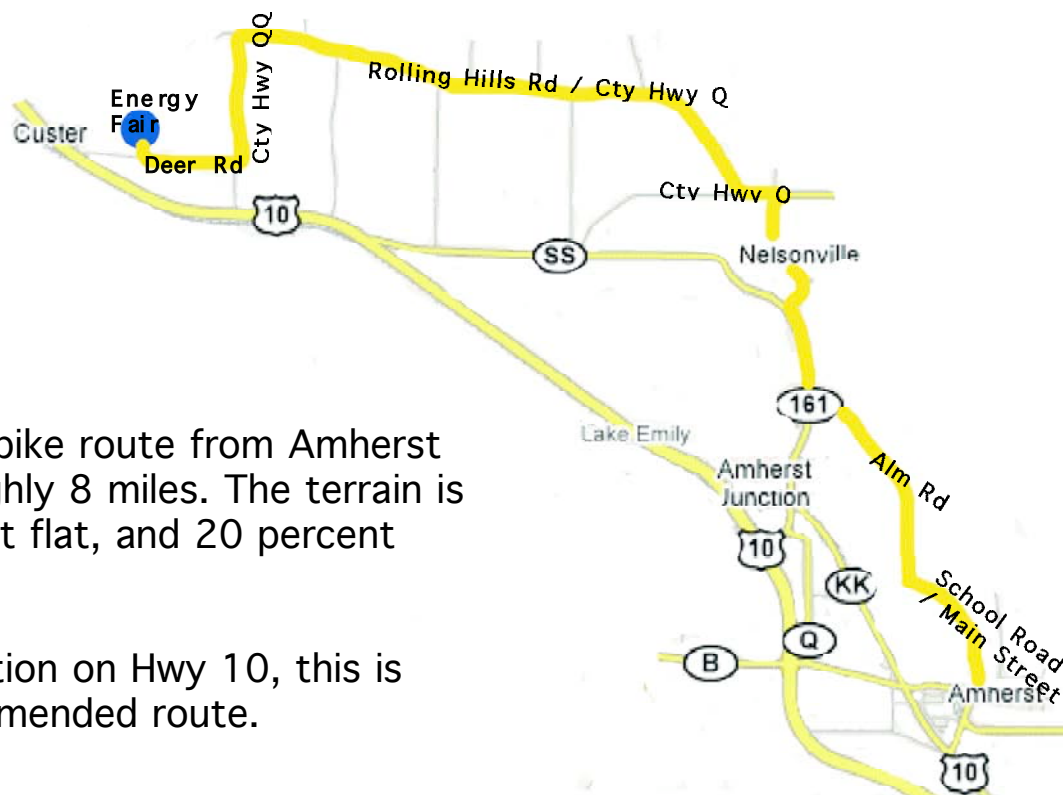


Energy Fair Bike Route

From Amherst to the MREA's Energy Fair



The Energy Fair bike route from Amherst to Custer is roughly 8 miles. The terrain is about 80 percent flat, and 20 percent rolling hills.

Due to construction on Hwy 10, this is the 2007 recommended route.

Complete Directions:

- Take Main Street, which turns into School Road north out of Amherst.
- Turn right on Alm Road.
- Turn right on Hwy 161.
- Turn right onto Hwy 161/Hwy A/Mill Road, and head through Nelsonville.
- Take a left on Hwy Q
- Take your next right to stay on Hwy Q (Rolling Hills Road).
- Take a left on Hwy QQ.
- Turn right on Deer Road.
- Proceed to Energy Fair bike entrance.



There will be bike parking available at the Energy Fair, thanks to Rudy Rack of Plover and the Bicycle Federation of Wisconsin.
